OUR WILL AND PLEASURE therefore is that you the said Edward William, Duke of Norfolk, to whom the cognizance of matters of this nature doth properly belong, do see this Our Order observed and kept and that you do also cause these Presents to be recorded in Our College of Arms to the need that Our Officer of Arms and all others upon occasion may take full notice and have knowledge thereof;

AND for so doing this shall be your Warrant.
