

a depth less than one metre below the level of the surface of the ground adjoining the grave;

(b) in the places numbered 1 and 3 above, in any grave space in which no interment has previously taken place, the burial may be allowed of any person for whom, or any member of the family for which that grave space has been reserved and appropriated, with the exclusive right of burial there, but no part of the coffin containing the body shall be less than one metre below the level of the surface of the ground adjoining the grave; and

(c) in the place numbered 4 above, in any vault or walled grave in the churchyard, burial may be allowed but every coffin buried in such vault or grave must be separately enclosed by stonework or brickwork properly cemented. (1358279)

The following Letters Patent were signed by Her Majesty The Queen on the 23 April 2011 in respect of the **Forced Marriage etc. (Protection and Jurisdiction) (Scotland) Bill asp 15**.

GREETING:

FORASMUCH as a Bill has been passed by the Scottish Parliament and has been submitted to Us for Our Royal Assent by the Presiding Officer of the Scottish Parliament in accordance with the Scotland Act 1998 the short Title of which Bill is set forth in the Schedule hereto but that Bill by virtue of the Scotland Act 1998 does not become an Act of the Scottish Parliament nor have effect in the Law without Our Royal Assent signified by Letters Patent under Our Scottish Seal (that is Our Seal appointed by the Treaty of Union to be kept and used in Scotland in place of the Great Seal of Scotland) signed with Our own hand and recorded in the Register of the Great Seal We have therefore caused these Our Letters Patent to be made and have signed them and by them do give Our Royal Assent to that Bill COMMANDING ALSO the Keeper of Our Scottish Seal to seal these Our Letters with that Seal.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Bromley on 27th April 2011 made the above-mentioned Orders under Sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, which will come into operation on 16th May 2011.

The effect of the Orders would be to:-

- (a) *introduce/extend/remove waiting and loading restrictions as specified in the Schedule to this notice;*
- (b) *introduce additional School Keep Clear markings as specified in the Schedule to this notice;*
- (c) *formalise an existing doctors bay as specified in the Schedule to this notice;*
- (d) *remove one time restricted free parking space from outside No. 515 Upper Elmers End Road, Beckenham (Eden Park Shop) to allow access for loading/unloading.*

A copy of the Orders may be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays at the Bromley Civic Centre, Stockwell Close, Bromley, Kent until the expiration of a period of 6 weeks from the date of making the Orders.

ANY person wishing to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant enabling Act or that any requirement of any such enabling Act or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with, may within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

SCHEDULE:-

WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS

No Waiting At Any Time:-

ADDINGTON ROAD, West Wickham, the north west side, from a point 6m south west of the south western kerblin of Courtfield Rise north eastwards to a point 7m north east of the north eastern kerblin of Courtfield Rise.

ALBEMARLE ROAD, Beckenham, the north side, (i) from a point 9m west of the western kerblin of Penrith Close eastwards to a point 9m east of the eastern kerblin of Penrith Close; (ii) from a point 9m west of the western kerblin of Sutton Close eastwards to a point 10m east of the eastern kerblin of Sutton Close.

BLACKBROOK LANE, Bromley, (a) the west side, from a point 3m south of the common boundary of Nos. 81 & 83 southwards to a point 10m south of the southern kerblin of Springfield Gardens; (b) the east side, from a point 8m north of a point opposite the northern kerblin of Springfield Gardens northwards to a point 4m north of a point opposite the common boundary of Nos. 81 & 83.
