THE A19 TRUNK ROAD (LINDISFARNE TO TYNE TUNNEL) (50 MILES PER HOUR AND 30 MILES PER HOUR SPEED RESTRICTION) ORDER

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State for Transport has made an Order under Sections 84(1)(a) and (2) of, and paragraph 27(1) of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, on the A19 Trunk Road in the District of South Tyneside which comes into force on Monday 5 December 2011.

THE BARNET (CRICKLEWOOD) (CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE) (PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO. 14) TRAFFIC ORDER 2011

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet on 1 December 2011 have made the above-mentioned Order under Sections 45, 46, 49, 51 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

THE BRENT (PRESCRIBED ROUTES) (NO. 7) ORDER 2011

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Brent made the above-mentioned Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985.
