### (AMENDMENT NO. 56) TRAFFIC ORDER 2012

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet has made on 23 February 2012 the above-mentioned Order under Sections 6 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

In order to prevent obstructive parking, improve traffic flow and general road safety, the general effect of the Order is to introduce new waiting restrictions in the borough, as follows.

At any time waiting restrictions will be provided on a certain length of:
