NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Bromley proposes to make the above-mentioned Orders under Sections 6, 45, 46, 47, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985 and all other enabling powers.

The effect of the Orders would be to:—

- (a) change of use of residents permit parking places in Walpole Road, Bromley to Pay & Display shared use parking places as specified in the Schedule to this notice;
- (b) introduce/amend waiting restrictions as specified in the Schedule to this notice;
- (c) remove the loading restrictions as specified in the Schedule to this notice;
- (d) reintroduce a residents permit bay in Chatsworth Avenue, Bromley as specified in the Schedule to this Order;
- (e) amend the Schedule to the On-Street Parking Place Order to reflect the removal of a residents bay outside No. 13 Chatsworth Avenue, Bromley due to the installation of a vehicle crossover and replace with Monday to Friday 11am to 1pm waiting restrictions;
- (f) introduce new disabled parking bays as specified in the Schedule to this notice;
- (g) remove the disabled parking bays as specified in the Schedule to this notice;
- (h) amend the Pay & Display parking places in Church Road, Elmfield Park and Elmfield Road (part of), Bromley from Zone B to Zone A
