THE A30 TRUNK ROAD (INNIS DOWNS TO INDIAN QUEENS, CORNWALL) (24 HOUR CLEARWAY) ORDER

Notice is given that the Secretary of State for Transport made this Order on 19 June 2012, coming into force on 2 July 2012, under section 1(1), 2(1) and (2), 3(2) and 4(1), the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the A30 Trunk Road (A30) and slip roads near Bodmin in the County of Cornwall.

INCLUSION OF FELTON ROAD IN EALING DEAN CONTROLLED ZONE JJ EXTENSION

THE EALING (EALING DEAN) (RESIDENTS PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO.7) ORDER 2012

THE EALING (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (SPECIAL PARKING AREA) (AMENDMENT NO. 517) ORDER

THE EALING (PARKING PLACES) (TELEPHONE PARKING) (EALING DEAN – ZONE JJ) (AMENDMENT NO. 1) ORDER 2012

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing Council, in connection with the inclusion of Felton Road in the extension to controlled parking zone JJ (Ealing Dean), on the 28th June

2012 made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985

The general effect of the Ealing (Ealing Dean) (Residents Parking Places) Amendment Order 2012 will be:

(a) to introduce a parking place for the use by residents, their visitors and business users on the north-east side of Felton Road;

(b) to provide that the parking place will operate between the hours of 10am and 11am and between 3pm and 4pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive (the controlled hours for Ealing Dean Zone);

(c) to provide that passenger vehicles, goods carrying vehicles, motorcycles and disabled persons vehicles may be left in a parking place without limitation on time during the controlled hours and that with the exception of motorcycles and disabled persons vehicles displaying a blue badge, a valid JJ zone permit or voucher must be displayed whilst parked therein.

3. The general effect of the Ealing (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Special Parking Area) (Amendment No. *) Order 2012 will be to introduce new waiting restrictions that apply at any time or during the Ealing Dean controlled hours in Felton Road.

4. The general effect of the Ealing (Parking Places) (Telephone Parking) (Ealing Dean – Zone JJ) Order 2012 will be to

(a) introduce a "shared use/PayByPhone" parking place operating between the hours of 10.00 am and 4.00 pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive on the south-west side of Felton Road;

(b) provide that passenger vehicles, goods carrying vehicles, motorcycles and disabled persons vehicles may be left in the parking places and that with the exception of motorcycles and vehicles displaying a disabled persons blue badge, a valid JJ zone permit must be displayed or payment made by mobile phone using the telephone payment parking system known as PayByPhone whilst parked in the parking place:

(c) provide that the charges for parking in the "shared use/ PayByPhone" parking place will be 60 pence for thirty minutes up to a maximum charge of £2.40 pence for the maximum 2 hour parking period. There will be a 20 pence transaction service charge payable; (d) Users of the telephone payment system should follow the instructions displayed in the parking place quoting the unique number relating to that parking place to the service provider and providing information as requested. Payment of the parking charge can then be made using most debit and credit cards. An optional charge of 10 pence will be payable to the service provider for text receipt for the parking session and expiry of parking reminder text messages.

5. Business Parking Permits will be available at a cost of £600 per

annum and Residents Parking Permits at a cost of £45 per annum.

6. Business Visitors Vouchers will be available at a cost of £1.20 per hour and Residents Visitors Vouchers will be available at a cost of 60p per hour.

7. Borough wide vouchers will be available to park in Felton Road at a cost of £1.20 per hour

8. The Orders, which will come into operation on the 2nd July 2012, other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders, are available for inspection at Customer Services Reception, Perceval House, 14-16 Uxbridge Road W5 2HL between 9:00am and 4:45pm on Monday to Friday, until the 9th August 2012.

9. If any person wishes to question the validity of any of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
