1. The Council of the London Borough of Hounslow proposes to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The general effect of the Waiting and Loading Restriction Amendment Order would be to further amend The London Borough of Hounslow (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 2008 so that waiting and loading by vehicles would be prohibited in the lengths of roads as specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice.

- (a) both sides, between the north-western kerb-line of Sutton Lane and a point 10.0 metres north-west of that kerb-line

Sarsen Avenue, Hounslow

- (a) both sides, between the south-eastern kerb-line of Sutton Lane to a point 10.0 metres south-east of that kerb-line

Stratton Close, Hounslow

- (a) both sides, between the south-eastern kerb-line of Sutton Lane to a point 10.0 metres south-east of that kerb-line

north-west side,

- (a) from a point 14.0 metres north-east of the extended building line of Nos. 139/141 Sutton Lane to a point 30.0 metres north-east of the south-western building line of No. 54 Sutton Lane

- (d) the south-western arm of the service road fronting Nos. 125 to 141 Sutton Lane, the north-east side, from the south-eastern kerb-line of Sutton Lane to a point 0.5 metres north-east of the boundary wall of Nos. 119/121 and 123/125 Sutton Lane

- (e) the south-western arm of the service road fronting Nos. 119 to 141 Sutton Lane, the south-west side, from the south-eastern kerb-line of Sutton Lane to a point 7.0 metres south-east of that kerb-line

1. The Council of the London Borough of Hounslow proposes to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 84(1), 84(2) and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and introduce road humps under section 90a of the Highways Act 1980.
2. Under Section 90a of the Highways Act 1980 the Council is proposing to introduce road humps in the locations detailed in Schedule 1 of this Notice.
3. The general effect of the Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools Order would be to further amend The Hounslow (Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools) (No. 1) Order 2008 to amend the description of the school keep clear markings in Queenswood Avenue and Wesley Avenue to incorporate the additional proposed traffic calming measures in this proposed scheme.
4. The general effect of the Waiting and Loading Restriction Amendment Order would be to further amend The London Borough of Hounslow (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 2008 so that waiting and loading by vehicles would be prohibited in the lengths of roads as specified in Schedules 2 to this Notice.
5. The general effect of the speed limit Order would be to impose a speed limit of 20 mph in the length of roads as detailed in Schedule 3 to this Notice.
