UNIVERSITIES OF OXFORD AND CAMBRIDGE ACT 1923

A Statute made by the University of Cambridge on the 19th October 2012 revising the existing Statutes of the University has been submitted for the approval of Her Majesty in Council, and notice of this having been submitted are published in accordance with the provisions of the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act 1923. Under the provision of the Act any petition must be received by the Privy Council Office, 2 Carlton Gardens, London SW1Y 5AA within eight weeks (exclusive of any University vacation).

The purpose of the proposed amendment is to alter Statute U, Chapter VI to allow the main provisions concerning the University's grievance procedures to be moved from the Statutes and into the Ordinances.
