1. Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Waltham Forest propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and introduce footway parking places under the GLC General Powers Act 1974.

2. The general effect of the Orders would be to:

(a) introduce waiting restrictions operating "at any time" into certain sections of Blackthorne Drive, Coningsby Gardens, Frederica Road, Grove Road, Higham Street, Kings Head Hill, McEntee Avenue, Sinclair Road, Waltham Way, Warren Road, Wigram Square and Woodview Avenue;

(b) Introduce waiting restrictions operating between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Monday to Saturdays into certain sections of Rectory Road;

(c) Introduce waiting restrictions operating "at any time" at the following junctions:-

- Antlers Hill and Boardman Avenue;
- Boardman Avenue, Sewardstone Gardens and Sewardstone Road;
- Chamberlain Place and Higham Street;
- Chivers Road and Windsor Road;
- Colville Road and Green Pond Road;
- Endlebury Road and Warren Road;
- Forest Road and Wigram Square;
- Green Pond Close and Green Pond Road;
- Grove Road and Harold Road;
- Gunners Grove and Harold Road;
- Higham Street and Sutherland Road;
- Kings Road and Station Road;
- Nelson Road and Tudor Road; and
- Rolls Park Road and Royston Avenue;

(d) Extend the lengths of existing waiting restrictions operating "at any time" in certain sections the following roads:

- Forest Road;
- Hawkdene;
- High Road Leyton;
- Hoe Street;

- Kings Head Hill;
- Larkshall Road;
- Stephenson Road

(e) Introduce uncontrolled footway parking places into certain sections of Woodview Avenue;

(f) Amend the layout of an existing parking place in a certain section of Woodville Road.

3. Copies of the Orders, the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Orders and of plans showing the location and effect of the Orders can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of a period of 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders are made or the Council decides not to make the Orders, at (a) The Information Desk, Town Hall, Forest Road, Walthamstow, E17 and (b) The Reception Desk, The London Borough of Waltham Forest, Low Hall, Argall Avenue, London, E10 7AS.

4. Any person desiring to object to either of the proposed Orders or to make any other representation should send a statement in writing of either their objection and the grounds thereof or of their representation to Traffic Orders, Engineering Design, Low Hall, Argall Avenue, London, E10 7AS quoting reference T02 by the end of a period of 21 days from the date on which this Notice is published. All objections must specify the grounds on which they are made.
