THE BARNET (BRENT CROSS STATION) (CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE) (PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO. 33) TRAFFIC ORDER 2013

THE BARNET (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING IN AMBULANCE BAYS) TRAFFIC ORDER 2013

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet has on the 14th March 2013 made the above-mentioned Orders under Sections 6, 45, 46, 49, 51 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

In order to ensure that the London Borough of Barnet's Controlled Parking Zones (CPZs) continue to operate effectively by improving parking opportunities and to cater for known demands, the general effect of the Orders will be to make amendments to the Brent Cross Station Controlled Parking Zone, as follows:

1. convert the existing short stay 'pay by phone' parking place outside Phildor Court, Golders Green Road, NW11 to a dual use resident/pay by phone parking place which would operate between 9am and 5.30pm Monday to Sunday;
2. convert the existing short stay 'pay by phone' parking place in Golders Manor Drive NW11, outside the north-western flank wall of No. 2 Heather Gardens to a resident permit holder only parking place which would operate between 11am and 12midday Monday to Friday;
3. convert the existing business permit holder only parking place outside Ray Court, Highfield Road, NW11 to a general resident/business permit holder parking place which would operate between 11am and 12midday Monday to Friday;
4. convert the existing resident permit holder only parking place in Elmcroft Crescent NW11, on the south-eastern side of the road outside the north-western flank wall of no. 88 Hamilton Road to a long stay 'pay by phone' parking place with a maximum stay of 6 hours 30 minute, which would operate between 10am and 5pm Monday to Friday;
5. convert the existing resident permit holder only parking place in Montpelier Rise NW11, on the south-eastern side of the road outside Menorah Primary School to a long stay 'pay by phone' parking place with a maximum stay of 6 hours 30 minute, which would operate between 10am and 5pm Monday to Friday;
6. convert a section of existing resident permit holder only parking place in Montpelier Rise NW11, on the south-eastern side of the road
