THE BARNET (GOLDERS GREEN) (CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE) (PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO. 47) TRAFFIC ORDER 2013

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet on 28 March 2013 have made the above-mentioned Orders under Sections 45, 46, 49, 51 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. In order to accommodate the introduction of 'dropped kerb' vehicle crossovers to enable access to off-street facilities, the general effect of the above Orders will be to modify the existing parking layout at the following locations, with a resultant loss of parking spaces as follows:

THE BRENT (MUHARRAM AND RAMADAN) (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS) (NO. 1) ORDER 2013

THE BRENT (MUHARRAM AND RAMADAN) (PARKING PLACES) (NO. 1) ORDER 2013

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Brent on 25 March 2013 made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985, the Parking Acts of 1986 and 1989 and the Traffic Management Act 2004. 2. The general effect of the 'Parking Places Amendment' Order will be to:

- shorten in length the existing shared use parking places in Brooksville Avenue at the location specified in Schedule 1 to this notice;
- increase in length the existing permit holders only parking place in Brooksville Avenue at the location specified in Schedule 2 to this notice;
- make minor drafting amendments to the existing shared use parking place situated outside No. 129 Salisbury Road.

3. The general effect of the 'Waiting and Loading Restrictions' Order will be further to amend the Brent (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1979, so that:

- waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be prohibited at any time in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 3 to this Notice;
- waiting for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle will be prohibited at any time in the length of street specified in Schedule 4 to this Notice;
- the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle will be prohibited (except on Sundays in the length of street specified in Schedules 3 and 4) unless there is in force a valid licence issued by the Brent Borough Council or the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;
- the use of any vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume, wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising will be prohibited;
- any existing prohibition on the waiting by vehicles, the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle or the use of any vehicle or animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising in the length of street specified in Schedules 3 and 4 to this Notice will be revoked.

4. The prohibitions referred to in sub-paragraph 3(a) and (b) above will not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in certain circumstances, e.g., the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; the taking in of petrol, etc., from roadside petrol stations; to licensed street traders, etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "Blue Badge" will apply.

5. The general effect of the:

(A) "Muharram and Ramadan Waiting and Loading Restriction" Order will be to apply the provisions of the Brent (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1979, so that during the Islamic periods of Muharram and Ramadan:

- waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be prohibited so that they will apply between 8.30 a.m. and 10.00 p.m. in certain lengths of the streets specified in Schedule 5 to this Notice;
- waiting by vehicles (for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) for a period of more than 40 minutes in the same place will be prohibited in the lengths of streets referred to in (i) above;
