FOOTWAY PARKING AMENDMENTS AND ADDITIONAL WAITING RESTRICTIONS

THE EALING (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (SPECIAL PARKING AREA) (AMENDMENT NO. *) ORDER 201*

THE EALING (FREE PARKING PLACES) (NO. 2) (AMENDMENT NO. *) ORDER 201*

THE EALING (PARKING PLACES) (STOP AND SHOP WITH ADDITIONAL CASHLESS PARKING) (AMENDMENT NO. *) ORDER 201*

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing propose to make the above mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Parking Places Order would be (a) to formally designate free parking places for vehicles to park with two wheels on the footway in Livingstone Road, Ruskin Road and Stanley Road without limit of time and (b) designate free parking places for vehicles to park on the carriageway in Livingstone Road and Alma Road.

3. The general effect of the Cashless Parking Places Amendment Order would be to introduce four 1 hour maximum stay stop and shop" free parking places in Livingstone Road and Ruskin Road near their junction with The Broadway which would operate between the hours of 8am and 6.30 pm on Mondays to Saturdays and 10am and 6.30pm on Sundays. Vehicles will be required to park in these parking places with all 4 wheels on the footway.

The bays would additionally allow vehicles to remain beyond the free parking period for an additional period of up to 2 hours on payment of a parking charge of £2 including the 20 pence transaction fee. The parking charge would be payable through the telephone payment system and would be required to be paid for by the end of the free parking period.

4. Users of the telephone payment system should follow the instructions displayed in the parking place quoting the unique number relating to

that parking place to the service provider and providing information as requested. Payment of the parking charge can then be made using most debit and credit cards. An optional charge of 10 pence would be payable to the service provider for text receipt for the parking session and expiry of parking reminder text messages. 5. The general effect of the Waiting Restriction Order would be to introduce double yellow line waiting restrictions applying at any time in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

6. The Orders, other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders, are available for inspection at Customer Services Reception, Perceval House, 14-16 Uxbridge Road W5 2HL between 9:00am and 4:45pm on Monday to Friday, until 6 weeks have elapsed from the date on which either the Orders are made or the Council decides not to make the Orders.

(Waiting restrictions applying at any time)

Alma Road, Southall

(a) the north-east side, between a point 2.6 metres south-east of a point opposite the north-western wall of No. 24 Alma Road and the common boundary of Nos. 28 and 30 Alma Road;

(b) the south-west side

(i) between its junction with Stanley Road and a point 1.6 metres south-east of a point opposite the south-eastern wall of No. 57 Stanley Road;

(ii) between a point 24.5 metres north-west of a point opposite the south-eastern wall of No. 57 Stanley Road and a point 31.8 metres north-west of that wall ;

(iii) between a point 60.0 metres north-west of a point opposite the south-eastern wall of No. 57 Stanley Road and a point 2.1 metres south-east of a point opposite the south-eastern wall of No. 63 Ruskin Road.

Livingstone Road

(a) the east and south-east side

(i) between a point 26.5 metres north of the northern kerb-line of The Broadway, Uxbridge Road and a point 2.1 metres north of the northern side of the rear access to Gardener House;

(ii) between a point 4.2 metres north of a point opposite the southern boundary of No. 40 Livingstone Road and a point opposite the south-western wall of the garage of No. 40 Livingstone Road;

(iii) between a point 34.2 metres north-east of a point opposite the south-western wall of the garage of No. 40 Livingstone Road and a point 40.9 metres north-east of that point;

(iv) between a point 57.2 metres north-east of a point opposite the south-western wall of the garage of No. 40 Livingstone Road and a point opposite the western wall of No. 63 Ruskin Road ;

(b) the west and north-west side

(i) between a point 26.5 metres north of the northern kerb-line of The Broadway, Uxbridge Road and a point 1.8 metres north of the northern side of the rear access to Garrod House;

(ii) between the common boundary of Nos. 41 and 43 Livingstone Road and a point 1.8 metres south-west of the common boundary of Nos. 45 and 47 Livingstone Road.

Ruskin Road

(a) the east side

(i) between a point 26.5 metres north of the northern kerb-line of The Broadway, Uxbridge Road and a point 35.3 metres north of that kerb-line;

(ii) between a point 79.1 metres north of the northern kerb-line of The Broadway, Uxbridge Road and a point 84.9 metres north of that kerb-line;

(iii) between a point 68.2 metres south of a point opposite the northern wall of No. 64 Ruskin Road and a point 74.1 metres south of that wall;

(iv) between a point opposite the northern wall of No. 64 Ruskin Road and its junction with Alma Road;
