1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Greenwich proposes to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Orders would be:

(a) to provide disabled persons parking places, which would be available for vehicles displaying a disabled persons blue badge, in the following locations:

- (i) Cambridge Green on the north-east side in close proximity to its junction with Green Lane;
- (ii) Corelli Road on the north-east side outside Nos. 93 to 99 Corelli Road;
- (iii) Egremont Road on the north-west side 3 metres north-east of Nos. 18/45 Russett Way;
- (iv) Glenlyon Road on the south-east side outside No. 26 Glenlyon Road;
- (v) Prince Henry Road on the north-west side outside Nos. 41 to 51 Prince Henry Road;
- (vi) Rockmount Road on the east side outside Nos. 13/15 Rockmount Road;
- (vii) Victoria Way on the north-east side outside Nos. 47 to 53 Victoria Way;
- (viii) Wickham Lane on the east side outside No. 65 Wickham Lane;
- (ix) William Barefoot Drive on the west side (the access road west of the main carriageway), adjacent to No. 2 The Mound;

(b) in Cambridge Green and Egremont Road to remove permit holders' parking spaces for one vehicle to provide the disabled persons parking places referred to in sub-paragraphs (a)(i) and (iii) respectively above; and

(c) in Victoria Way to remove a free parking place to provide the disabled persons parking place referred to in sub-paragraph (a)(vii) above.

3. A copy of the proposed Orders and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders are available for inspection during normal office hours until the end of six weeks from the date on which the Orders are made or, as the case may be, the Council decides not to make the Orders, at the Directorate of Regeneration, Enterprise and Skills, Strategic Transportation, Royal Borough of Greenwich, The Woolwich Centre, 35 Wellington Street, SE18 6HQ.

5. Any person who wishes to object to or make other representations about the proposed Orders should send a statement in writing by 13th August 2013, specifying the grounds on which any objection is made, to the Royal Borough of Greenwich, PO Box 485, Kemp House, 152-160 City Road, London, EC1V 2NV (quoting reference PCL/TMO/JB/1000001285).

6. Persons objecting to the proposed Orders should be aware that, in view of the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985, this Council would be legally obliged to make any comments received in response to this notice open to public inspection.

THE M4 MOTORWAY (JUNCTION 49, PONT ABRAHAM, CARMARTHENSHIRE) (50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) REGULATIONS 2013

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Welsh Ministers have made the M4 Motorway (Junction 49, Pont Abraham, Carmarthenshire) (50 MPH Speed Limit) Regulations 2013.

The Regulations impose a maximum speed limit of 50 miles per hour (instead of the general 70 miles per hour speed limit imposed on motorways by the Motorway Traffic (Speed Limit) Regulations 1974 (S.I. 1974/502)) on the length of the westbound carriageway of the M4 Motorway that extends from a point 600 metres south of its junction with the roundabout at Pont Abraham (Junction 49) in the county of Carmarthenshire to its junction with that roundabout.

The Regulations will come into force on 23 July 2013.
