- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Greenwich proposes to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Orders would be, in Randall Place:
- (a) to provide a disabled persons parking place, for one vehicle, opposite No. 7 Randall Place; and
- (b) to remove one permit holders' parking space opposite No. 7 Randall Place to provide the disabled persons parking place referred to in sub-paragraph (a) above.
- 3. THE GREENWICH (FREE PARKING PLACES) (DISABLED PERSONS) (AMENDMENT NO. 47) ORDER 2013

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Greenwich on 13th September 2013 made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The Orders will come into operation on 23rd September 2013.
- 2. The general effect of the Orders will be:
- (a) in Warren Lane to remove four free parking places and provide double yellow line 'at any time' waiting restrictions throughout the entire length of Warren Lane;
- (b) in Rochester Way to provide single yellow line waiting restrictions: (i) on the north side, from 45 metres west of Welling Way northwestwards for a distance of 15 metres, that would operate between 8.00am and 6.30pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive; and (ii) on the south-west side, from a point 110 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of Reifield Road north-westwards for 14 metres, that would operate between 8.30am and 6.30pm on Mondays to Sundays inclusive;
- (c) in St. Merryn Close to provide a disabled persons parking place outside No. 9 St. Merryn Close;
- (d) provide double yellow line 'at any time' waiting restrictions in lengths of streets referred to in Schedule 1 to this Notice; and (e) provide 'at any time' waiting and loading restrictions in the lengths
- of street referred to in Schedule 2 to this Notice.

Schedule 1 – 'At any time' waiting restrictions

Bentham Road: south side, for 10 metres either side of Southwood Road; Berryhill: both sides, for 10 metres north-east of Glenesk Road; Boneta Road, north to south arm, east side, from 14.2 metres north of Woolwich Church Street for 26.5 metres; Charlton Park Lane: north-west side, from a point 43.5 metres south-west of Cemetery Lane south-westwards for 16.5 metres; Earlshall Road: both sides for 10 metres south-west of Glenesk Road; Glenesk Road: (1) north-east side, for 10 metres either side of Berry Hill; and (2) south-west side, for 10 metres either side of Earlshall Road; Greenwich High Road: northwest side, from 7 metres north-east of No. 39 Greenwich High Road north-eastward for 24.3 metres; Hither Farm Road: (1) south-west, from No. 135 Hither Farm Road south-eastward to the south-eastern boundary of No. 124 Hither Farm Road; (2) north-east side, from opposite No. 135 Hither Farm Road south-eastward to opposite No. 74 Hither Farm Road; (3) north-west side, for 8 metres outside No. 1 Hither Farm Road; (4) the south-east side, for 12 metres outside No. 74 Hither Farm Road; Marshalls Grove: throughout the north side; Nathan Way: (1) north and north-west side, between Pettman Crescent and 45 metres south-west of Broughton Road; (2) south-east side, from 96.5 metres south-east of Pettman Crescent south-eastward for 50.5 metres; and (3) south-east side, for 46 metres opposite Nos. 67 to 69 Nathan Way; Southwood Road, SE28: both sides, for 27.5 metres south of Bentham Road.
