PROPOSED MINOR AMENDMENTS IN FRIARY ROAD, GROVE PLACE AND HIGHLANDS AVENUE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing ("the Council") proposes to make the above mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

- 2. The general effect of the Acton Central Parking Places Order and the Waiting Restriction Amendment Order would be to:
- (a) remove a 4 metres length of permit holder parking place in Grove Place outside No. 35;
- (b) remove the solo motor cycle parking area in Highlands Avenue and extend the adjacent permit parking place by 7.5 metres in its place.
- 3. The general effect of the Disabled Persons Parking Place Order would be to introduce a free parking place for vehicles displaying the disabled person's blue badge permit where such vehicles may be left without limit on time in Friary Road on the north-west side adjacent to Harrys Bar.
- 4. The general effect of the Free Parking Places (Amendment No. *) Order 201* would be to provide 3 free limited time bays in Friary Road adjacent to the disabled parking place in paragraph 3 above operative from 8am to 6.30 Mondays to Saturdays available for a maximum of 1 hour parking with no return permitted for 1 hour.
- 5. The Orders, other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders, are available for inspection at Customer Services Reception, Perceval House, 14-16 Uxbridge Road W5 2HL between 9:00am and 4:45pm on Monday to Friday, until 6 weeks have elapsed from the date on which either the Orders are made or the Council decides not to make the Orders.
