1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Hackney proposes to make the above-mentioned Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended

2. In line with the details consulted with the residents and businesses of South Hackney in September 2013, and the consultation summary booklet, the general effect of the proposed Orders will be to;

implement permit bays, shared use bays, pay and display bays, loading bays and no waiting at any time (double yellow lines) and no loading restrictions on the following roads or part of roads within South Hackney;

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Merton (“the Council”) have made the above mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The Orders were made on 22nd January 2014 and shall come into operation on 27th January 2014.

2. The general effects of the Parking Places Order are to remove a number of parking bays outside Nos. 1, 16 and 35 Burghley Road to accommodate the installation of traffic calming measures, to introduce additional parking bays in the vicinities of Nos. 23 and 65 Burghley Road and adjacent to No. 40 Calonne Road and to change the length of the parking bay outside No. 19 Burghley Road. The general effects of the Waiting and Loading Restriction Order are to make consequential amendments to the waiting restrictions in Burghley Road and Calonne Road following the changes to the layout of the parking bays.

3. The Orders, other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders and traffic calming measures can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays at Merton Link, Merton Civic Centre, London Road, Morden, Surrey.

4. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Act, or that any of the relevant requirements of the Act, or of any relevant regulations made under that Act have not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, make an application for the purpose to the High Court.
