NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet propose to make the above-mentioned Order under Sections 45, 46, 49, 51, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

In order to accommodate the introduction of a 'dropped kerb' vehicle crossover enabling access to off-street facilities, the general effect of the above Order would be to modify the existing parking layout at the following location, with a resultant loss of parking spaces as follows:

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Brent propose to make the above mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985, the Parking Acts of 1986 and 1989 and the Traffic Management Act 2004.

2. The general effect of the 'Disabled Persons Parking Places' Order would be to:

- (a) designate parking places in certain lengths of the streets specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice in which vehicles authorised by the Order may be left for any period without charge;
- (b) provide that the parking places would operate "at any time";
- (c) specify, in respect of the parking places, that disabled persons' vehicles displaying in the relevant position a disabled person's badge (commonly referred to as "the Blue Badge") issued by any local authority under the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 may be left therein;
- (d) provide that certain vehicles may wait in the parking places in certain circumstances, e.g., to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes), etc;
- (e) revoke the existing disabled parking places outside No. 78 Burrows Road, NW10 5SH, No. 33 Hawkins Road, NW10 9DR, No. 53 Temple Road, NW2 6PN, No. 140 Victoria Road, NW10 6QB, No. 6 Woodstock Road, HA0 4EP and No. 53 Yewfield Road, NW10 9TD.

3. The general effect of the above 'Free Permit Parking Places' Order would be to:

- (a) re-designate existing free parking places for vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge (commonly referred to as "the Blue Badge") in the streets specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice to free personalised parking places for vehicles displaying a Brent issued personalised disabled persons parking places permit issued under the Order;
- (b) provide that the parking places would operate "at any time";
- (c) provide that a permit may be issued by the Council on application being made by a disabled person in possession of a Brent issued blue badge and:

- (i) in receipt of the Disability Living Allowance with the higher rate of mobility component for an indefinite period; or
- (ii) in receipt of the higher rate of Attendance Allowance for applicants aged 65 or over; or
- (iii) where the applicant does not drive and has appointed a nominated carer to drive for them, the carer is in receipt of the Carer's Allowance award.

4. The general effect of the 'Parking Places Amendment' Orders would be to:

- (a) increase in length existing permit holders only parking places following the revocation of the no longer required disabled persons parking places in Temple Road and Yewfield Road;
- (b) shorten in length existing permit holders only parking places in Algernon Road to enable the installation of a disabled person parking place;
- (c) shorten in length existing permit holders only parking places in Victoria Road to enable the installation of a personalised disabled person parking place;
- (d) shorten in length existing Wembley Event Day parking places in Braemar Avenue and Verney Street to enable the installation of a disabled person parking place.

5. A copy of the proposed Orders, of relevant Orders of 2001, 2004, 2008 and 2012 (and of the Orders which have amended those Orders) of the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Orders and of maps which indicate each length of road to which the Orders relate can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of a period of 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders are made or the Council decides not to make the Orders at Brent Customer Services, Brent Civic Centre, Engineers Way, Wembley, Middlesex, HA9 0FJ.
