##### GRAND UNION VILLAGE - WAITING RESTRICTIONS

##### THE EALING (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (SPECIAL PARKING AREA) (AMENDMENT NO. 604) ORDER 2014

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing on the 20th March 2014 made the above mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Waiting Restriction Order will be to impose restrictions on waiting by vehicles which would apply at any time in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.
3. The Order, which will come into operation on 24th March 2014, other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order, are available for inspection at Customer Services Reception, Perceval House, 14-16 Uxbridge Road W5 2HL between 9:00am and 4:45pm on Monday to Friday, until the 1st May 2014.
4. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
