- 2. The general effect of the Prescribed Route Order would be to close the service road fronting Nos. 52 to 78 High Street Southall to all vehicular traffic other than that using the defined route to the car park at the rear of Nos. 44 to 56 High Street. The area would be paved to provide a pedestrianized public space which would be available for community events.
- 3. The general effect of the Waiting Restriction Order would be to revise the restrictions to take account of the removal of the service road.
- 4. The general effect of the Parking Place Orders would be to revoke the existing free parking places and disabled persons parking place in the service road.
- 5. The general effect of the Loading Place Order would be to revoke the loading place in the service road and provide a replacement 30 minute limit loading place in High Street which will operate between 10am and 8pm on Mondays to Saturdays and between 2pm and 8pm on Sundays
- 6.
