

4. The temporary prohibition or restriction of the use of Meaford Road in order to carry out the replacement, maintenance and/or refurbishment of the existing surface water drainage and the temporary prohibition or restriction of the use of the Northern Access Road in order to carry out the alterations and upgrade works to the existing Northern Access Road; and

5. The application or disapplication of legislation relevant to the Proposed Development and described in the Application.

Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA)

Due to its nature, the Proposed Development is “EIA Development” for the purposes of the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2009. This means that the Proposed Development constitutes development for which an Environmental Impact Assessment (“EIA”) is required. The Application is therefore accompanied by an Environmental Statement.
