Under the provisions of the Act any petition must be received within eight weeks (exclusive of any University vacation) by the Privy Council Office, 2 Carlton Gardens, London SW1Y 5AA or email pcosecretariat@pco.gov.uk.

The purpose of the proposed amendments is to bring these statutes into line with amendments passed by the President and Fellows to include changes to Professorial Fellowships; Fellowships by Examination; clarification of leave of absence for Fellows by Examination; and the addition of Development Director to the list of College Officers.
