

During the closure of the westbound carriageway, vehicles wishing to travel westbound over the bridge would be diverted at M4 junction 21 to take the M4 westbound over the Second Severn Crossing to junction 23A (Magor), then eastbound on the M4/M48 towards Chepstow. During the eastbound carriageway and slip road closure, vehicles wishing to travel eastbound would be diverted on the same route in the reverse direction.

Traffic wishing to join the M48 westbound at junction 1 would be diverted on the M48/M4 eastbound to the Almondsbury Interchange, then southbound on the M5 to the A38 Interchange at junction 16. Traffic would turn at this junction to join the M5 northbound to Almondsbury Interchange and then follow the diversion route described above over the Second Severn Crossing.

During the closure of the footpath / cycle track described above, cyclists and pedestrians would be diverted to use the footpath and cycle track adjacent to the westbound carriageway of the M48.

The carriageway closures, slip road closures, footpath / cycle track closure and diversion routes would be clearly indicated by traffic signs during the event.

The closures would not apply to emergency service vehicles.

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
