THE LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK hereby gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under Section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of the following areas of public highway shown hatched black on the plan attached to the draft Order:-

The area of public highway to be stopped up is the rear of the footway on the north side of Great Southwark Street adjacent to the Grotto Podiums Open Space, from the edge of the perimeter fence at the open space adjacent to King's Court to the edge of the perimeter fence dividing the sports area from the public seating area, measuring 25.3 metres in length and 3.7 metres in width.

All of the area to be stopped up falls within the London Borough of Southwark

IF THE ORDER IS MADE the stopping up will be authorised to enable the development described in the Schedule to this Notice to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission resolved to be granted by the Council on 30 January 2018 and to be issued under Part III of the Act under local planning authority reference number 17/AP/0367.
