The King's most Excellent Majesty in Council.

His Majesty in Council was this Day pleased to appoint the following Sheriffs, viz.

John Harding, of Cheshunt, Esq; Warwick, Martin Baldwin, of Meriden, Efq;

Madrid, Jan. 1, N. S. The Count de Alta: mira, a Grandee of Spain of the first Class, and Lord Chamberlain of his Catholick Majesty's Houshold (who was a particular Favourite of the late King Lewis) was taken ill on the 22d past, and some Days after a Gangrene appeared in one of his Legs, so that on the 27th ir was necessary to cut it off. He has fince had an intermitting Fever, but the Physicians having given him the Jesuits Bark, are yet in Hopes of his Recovery. On the 26th past Sig. Canale, Ambassadour from the Republick of Venice, made his sirst Visit to the Marques de Grimaldo, and has fince sollicited Audiences of their Catholick Majesties; he has also notified his Arrival to the foreign Ministers residing at this Court, who thereupon have paid him their Visits. On the 30th a Courier from Paris paffed through this Place with Difpatches to the Abbot de Livry his most Christian Majesty's Ambassadour at Lisbon, to whom it is said he carries Orders to in-

fift that his Portuguele Majefty's Sccretary of State shall pay to him (the said Ara-bastadour) the first Visit, and in case of his not doing fo, to come away immediately from Lisbon.

Turin, Jun. 6, N. S. On Monday last, being New-Year's Day, the Senate and Magiftracy of Turin went to Court in their Formalities, and had the Honour of complimenting their Sardinian Majestica, and the Prince and Princese of Piedmont on that Occasion, and were admitted to kils their Hands; as were also the Nobility of both Sexes. same Day and the following, Mr. Molesworth, the British Envoy, had publick Audiences of the King and Queen of Sardinia, the Prince and Princese, the Duke d'Aoste, and the Princesses of Carignan. The Princele Louila and Prince Eugene de Soissons excused themselves from receiving any publick Compliments, the fift being in a Convent, and the last at the Academy: Howthe same Evening. The Prince of Piedmont has kept his Chamber two or three Days, by reason of an Inflammation in his Foot ; but his Royal Highness appeared To-Day at the King's Levee.
