HIS Britannick Majefty's Ship the Durfley, Captain Purvis Commander, came inco Port fome Days ago; and is to praceed from hence to Port Mahon.

Lisbon, Yan. 9, N. S. His Britannick Majefty's Ship the Limbe-Galley failed from hence for Cadiz on the ift Inftant; and on the sth the Argyle entred this Harbour from Cadiz. There ftill remain here His Britannick Majefty's Ships the Ludlow-Caftle and Sea-Horfe; the firlt of which will fhordy proceed for the Downs.

Turix, Jan. 17, N. s. The Princefs of Piedmont having been indifpofed and kept her Chamber fome Days, the firft private Ball in her Highnefs's Apartment, which was to have been on the $13^{\text {th }}$ Inftant but was deferred, is upon her Royal Highnefs's Recovery to be this Night. None are to dance but the Perfons named, nor any Spectators to be admitted but by Tickets. The cold Weather continues, and the Winter is judged to be the fevereft that has been known in this Country fince the hard Froft in 1709; which raifes the Price of every thing, efpecially of Wood for Fireing.

Turin, 7 ann. 20, N. S. Snow having newly fallen pretty thick, the Prince of Piedmont again diverted himfelf on the 18th with a Cavalcade of Sleds, which was more numerous and fplendid than the former. His Roy al Highnefs drove the Sled where fat the Princefs Ifabella di Carignan. The Marquefs Luflini is arrived here with a numerous Retinue and the Character of Envoy from the Governour General of the Milanefe, to compliment this Court upon the Marriage of the Prince of Piedmont. To Night there is to be a fecend Gall in the Princef's's Apartment, which is to concinue twice a Week during the Carnaval.

Srockbolm, Jan. 6, o.s. His Swêdihh Majefty having been prevented by a Thaw from performing the Journey he intended in order to take the Diverfion of Hunting, returned hither on the laft Day of the old Year at Night. On

New.Years's-Day, at Six in the Morning, the Guards were drawn up, and ulhered in the New Year as ufual with feveral Difcharges of their FireArms. At the tame time the Senators and re fpeative Colleges of this Kingdom, with the Officers of the Army and of the Court, waited on their Swedifh Majefties to wifh them a happy New Year, as did the Foreign Minifters and other Perfons of Diftinetion after Church, and M. Beftuchef, the Rufian Envoy, had the Honour of Dining with their Majefties. At Nighe there was a Ball at Court, and a very numcrous Appearance of Perfons of Quality of both Sexes. The Joy of this Day was encreafed by her Swedih Majefty's being happily recovered of a Pleuritick Pain, which it was apprehended would have ended in a Fever. The Duke of Holitein has notified not only to their Swedifh Majefties, but likewife to each of the Senators by Letter, his being contrasted to the Princefs Anna Petrowna the Czar's eldeft Daughter, and his Minifter has received their Compliments of Congratulation refpeftively.
