Notice is hereby given, in pursuance of section 91(1) of the Animal Health Act 1981, that the Parliamentary Under Secretary of State for the Department for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs has made the following order:

#### STATUTORY INSTRUMENTS 2022 NO. 926

#### THE AFRICAN SWINE FEVER (IMPORT CONTROLS) (ENGLAND AND SCOTLAND) ORDER 2022 (MADE 31ST AUGUST 2022)

This Order, which came into force on 1st September 2022, provides for restrictions on the importation of porcine products into England and Scotland from European Union Member States, European Free Trade Association States, Greenland and the Faroe Islands for the purpose of preventing the incursion of African Swine Fever.

The restrictions prohibit imports of certain pork products unless they have been produced to relevant EU commercial standards, or that they are for personal consumption/use only and are under 2kg in weight.

The Order applies in England and Scotland.

#### NOTICE OF THE GRANT OF A DROUGHT ORDER IN THE RIVER OUSE CATCHMENT

Following an application by Yorkshire Water Services Limited to the Secretary of State for a drought order in the River Ouse catchment under section 73 of the Water Resources Act 1991 (as amended), on 25 October 2022 the drought order was granted by the Secretary of State and will cease to have effect on 25 April 2023. The drought order permits an increase in the volume of water that Yorkshire Water Services Limited can abstract at Moor Monkton when the River Ouse flows at Skelton monitoring station are below 1,000,000 cubic metres per day.

#### STATUTORY NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR DROUGHT PERMIT AT HAWK'S TOR PIT

#### SECTION 79A OF THE WATER RESOURCES ACT 1991

TAKE NOTICE that due to a serious water shortage (or a threat thereof) in the Colliford Water Resource Zone ("WRZ") caused by an exceptional shortage of rain, South West Water Limited ("SWW") of Peninsula House, Rydon Ln, Exeter EX2 7HR is applying to the Environment Agency for a drought permit at Hawk's Tor Pit ("the Drought Permit") under section 79A of the Water Resources Act 1991. SWW previously held a temporary licence to abstract 10 megalitres per day from Hawk's Tor Pit between 16 June 1977 and 28 February 1986. SWW has previously been granted two drought orders in 1995 and 1996 for Hawk's Tor Pit, which permitted SWW to temporarily abstract up to 10 megalitres a day and 20 megalitres a day respectively.

The Drought Permit, if granted, will allow SWW to abstract no more than 8 megalitres per day of water from Hawk's Tor Pit for public water supply and/or to refill Colliford Reservoir directly until 30 April 2023. This is a new abstraction.

SWW is applying for this Drought Permit to reduce the risk of drought permits or orders being required in Spring/Summer 2023, to assist the recovery of water supply resources in Colliford WRZ which have been excessively depleted as a result of drought, and to assist the maintenance of water supply across Colliford WRZ, thereby reducing risk to supply in 2023.

SWW will show that the deficiency of water supply or a threat thereof relates to an "exceptional shortage of rainfall" within its drought permit application.
