LONDON BOROUGH OF BRENT, THE BRENT (PARKING PLACES) (WEMBLEY STADIUM AREA) (NO. *) ORDER 202*, THE BRENT (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO. *) ORDER 202*

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Brent propose to make the above mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by section 8 of and Part I of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985.

2. The general effect of the 'Parking Places' Order would be to designate parking places in certain lengths of Hilltop Avenue that would operate between 10.00 a.m. and Midnight on an event day (the relevant event day permit provisions would apply).

3. The general effect of the 'Waiting and Loading Restriction' Order would be to further amend the Brent (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1979, so that:-

(a) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited at any time in certain length of streets specified in the Schedule to this Notice;
