PETROLEUM ACT 1998 NOTICE OF THE ISSUE OF A SUBMARINE PIPELINE WORKS AUTHORISATION

The North Sea Transition Authority gives notice that it has decided to issue, and in consequence has issued, a works authorisation to be held by Spirit Energy Production UK Limited whose address is 1st Floor, 20 Kingston Road, Staines-upon-Thames, TW18 4LG for the construction and use of a pipeline between the Central Production Platform – CPP1 and Drilling Platform – DP8.

The North Sea Transition Authority (NSTA) is the business name of the Oil and Gas Authority (OGA). The OGA remains the legal name of the company. References in this notice to the NSTA should be interpreted as the OGA.

Except with the consent of the NSTA, the 75 Millimetre Power Cable shall only be used to convey Electrical Power and Fibre Communications.

The pipeline may be used by the Holder and with the Holder's agreement, and with the consent of the NSTA, by other persons.

Spirit Energy Production UK Limited have been appointed operator of the pipeline(s).
