THE CITY OF WESTMINSTER (PRESCRIBED ROUTES) (NO. 7) TRAFFIC ORDER 2023

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Westminster City Council on 17th April 2023 made the above Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Order will be to permanently increase the hours of operation of certain Pedestrian Zone restrictions in the Chinatown area initially introduced by way of Temporary Traffic Order during the pandemic period, that is:

- (a) in Gerrard Street, a prohibition of vehicles operating “at any time”, except for loading / unloading by goods vehicles between 7.00 a.m. and 11.00 a.m.;
- (b) in Lisle Street, a prohibition of vehicles operating between 11.00 a.m. and midnight;
- (c) in Newport Place (the northern arm), a prohibition of vehicles operating between 11.00 a.m. on any one day and 7.00 a.m. on the following day, except for access to premises and off-street parking;
- (d) in Newport Place (the southern arm), a prohibition of vehicles operating between 11.00 a.m. on any one day and 7.00 a.m. on the following day; and
- (e) in Wardour Street, between a point 9.2 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerb-line of Lisle Street and its junction with Shaftesbury Avenue, a prohibition of vehicles operating between 11.00 a.m. and midnight.

The above prohibitions will operate throughout the week.

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Westminster City Council on 17th April 2023 made the above Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Order will be to prohibit all buses, except for “local buses”, from entering the following lengths of road:

- (a) Chester Row, between South Eaton Place and Elizabeth Street;
- (b) Chester Square (north-western arm), between Elizabeth Street and Chester Square (south-western arm);
- (c) Chester Square (south-eastern arm), between Elizabeth Street and the north-western boundary of No. 46 Chester Square;
- (d) Eaton Square (south-eastern arm), between South Eaton Place and Eccleston Street; and
- (e) Elizabeth Street, between Eaton Square (central arm) and Ebury Street.

Exemptions will be provided for local buses (such as those operated by Transport for London) and certain local school buses to enter the area.
