1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Westminster City Council on 4th March 2024 made the following Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49, 63 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended:

- The City of Westminster (A Zone) (Amendment No. 50) Order 2024;
- The City of Westminster (D Zone) (Amendment No. 9) Order 2024;
- The City of Westminster (Loading Bays) (Amendment No. 54) Order 2024;
- The City of Westminster (Prescribed Routes) (No. 3) Traffic Order 2024; and
- The City of Westminster (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 530) Order 2024.

2. The general effect of the Orders will be to:

(a) introduce advisory contra-flow cycling in the following lengths of road:

- (i) Alderney Street, between its junctions with Warwick Way and Clarendon Street;
- (ii) Clarendon Street, between its junctions with Sutherland Street and Cumberland Street;
- (iii) Cumberland Street, between its junction with the carriageway to the south-east of the island site at its south-eastern junction with Winchester Street and its north-western junction with Winchester Street;
- (iv) Gloucester Street, between its junction with St. George's Drive and Cambridge Street;
- (v) Noel Street, between its junctions with Wardour Street and Berwick Street;
- (vi) Old Compton Street, between its junctions with:

- Wardour Street and Dean Street;
- Dean Street and Frith Street;
- Frith Street and Greek Street; and
- Greek Street and Charing Cross Road;

(vii) Sussex Street, between its junctions with Cumberland Street and Sutherland Street; and

(viii) Winchester Street, between the common boundary of Nos. 105 and 107 Winchester Street and its junction with Cumberland Street;

(b) introduce one-way working with advisory contraflow cycling in the following directions and lengths of road:

- (i) Cambridge Street, north-westbound, between its junctions with Clarendon Street and Warwick Way;
- (ii) Cumberland Street, south-eastbound, between its junctions with Gloucester Street and Lupus Street;
- (iii) Sutherland Row, south-westbound;
- (iv) Warwick Square (north-western north-east to south-west arm), north-eastbound, between its junctions with Cambridge Street and Warwick Square (south-western north-west to south-east arm); and
- (v) Winchester Street, south-eastbound, between its junctions with Gloucester Street and Lupus Street;

(c) introduce a mandatory north-westbound contra-flow cycle lane on the south-west side of Douglas Street, between its junctions with Chapter Street and Osbert Street / Vincent Square;

(d) amend existing "no entry" prohibitions having effect in the roads and lengths of road referred to in paragraphs 2(a), (b) and (c) above so as to exempt pedal cycles;

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Westminster City Council proposes to make the above Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Orders would be to:

(a) shorten the residents' parking place outside Nos. 6 to 9 Onslow Close by 7 metres at its eastern end; and

(b) introduce a "White Badge" disabled person's personal parking place outside No. 9 Onslow Close – the footway would also be widened at this location and a dropped kerb introduced as part of the proposed measures.
