Notice of publication of the 'Working Together' consultation, a Statement of Steps and Consultation Measures under Regulation 29 (2b) (3a and b) of the Water Environment (Water Framework Directive) (England and Wales) Regulations 2017

Natural Resources Wales has published its Working Together consultation, the first in a series of three public consultations that lead to updated River Basin Management Plans in 2027. This is a Wales wide consultation encompassing the Dee River Basin District and the Western Wales River Basin District, allowing anyone with an interest in the water environment or the river basin planning process the opportunity to comment.

The consultation has begun and will run until the 20 of December 2024. Any person may make representations to Natural Resources Wales regarding the statement of steps and consultation measures for the Dee and Western Wales River Basin Districts by completing the online consultation at the Citizen Space consultation hub.

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE WITHOUT COURT ORDER PROCEEDS OF CRIME ACT 2002, PART 5, CHAPTER 3, SECTION 297A

IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATUTORY INSTRUMENT 2015 NO. 857

That on 26th February 2024 a quantity of cash, namely £10,430 (est) was seized from Tu Anh LE at British Transport Police, Peninsular, Manchester.

I, Paul Attwell, Detective Inspector with British Transport Police, a senior officer within the meaning of 297A(6) (aa) of Proceeds of Crime Act 2002 (POCA) am satisfied that the cash (plus interest accrued) or part of it is:

- a) recoverable property; or
- b) is intended by any person for use in unlawful conduct as per s297A(2) POCA.

Any person may object to the proposed forfeiture of this cash within 30 days, starting with the day after the notice is given. Accordingly, the period for objecting to this notice expires on 6th July 2024.

If no objection is received at the above address within the prescribed period stated herein the cash will be forfeited but this is subject to an appeal (within the next 31 days) which must be made directly to the Magistrates' court that granted the detention order. (4640901)
