LONDON BOROUGH OF HARROW THE HARROW (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING OUTSIDE SCHOOLS) (AMENDMENT NO. 8) TRAFFIC ORDER 2024 THE HARROW (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO. 140) TRAFFIC ORDER 2024

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Harrow on 12 August 2024 made the above mentioned Orders under Sections 6, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985 and all other enabling powers.

2. The general effect of the Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools Order will be to extend the lengths of the existing School Keep Clear restrictions in Abercorn Road, Bacon Lane, Camrose Avenue, Kenmore Avenue and Marsh Lane.
