NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that National Highways Limited (Company no.9346363) has revoked an existing Order and made a new Order on the A43 Trunk Road, in the County of West Northamptonshire, to enable a new roundabout to be constructed and maintenance works to be carried out.

The effect of the Order, will be to, at different times, –

(1) impose a 50 miles per hour speed limit on the northbound carriageway of the A43 between points 1150 metres southwest and 400 metres northeast of the centreline of the A413 overbridge, near Silverstone;

(2) impose a 40 miles per hour speed limit on –

(a) the northbound carriageway of the A43 from a point 400 metres northeast of the centreline of the A413 overbridge, near Silverstone, to a point 319 metres southwest of its roundabout junction with Brackley Road (Abthorpe Roundabout), near Towcester; and

(b) the southbound carriageway of the A43 from a point 70 metres southwest of its junction with Abthorpe Roundabout, to a point 850 metres northeast of the centreline of the A413 overbridge, near Silverstone;

(3) close –

(a) the northbound and southbound carriageways of the A43 between the roundabout junction with the A421 and the B4031 (Barley Mow Roundabout), near Evenley, and its roundabout junction with the A5 (Towcester Roundabout), at Towcester;

(b) any slip road or link road leading to or from the length of the A43 described in (3)(a) above;

(c) the layby adjacent to –

(i) the northbound carriageway of the A43 approximately 700 metres southwest of the centrepoint of Abthorpe Roundabout; and

(ii) the southbound carriageway of the A43 approximately 800 metres southwest of the centrepoint of Abthorpe Roundabout;

(4) close the northbound carriageway of the A43 from a point 1100 metres south of the centrepoint of Abthorpe Roundabout to a point 250 metres south of the centrepoint of Abthorpe Roundabout and allow traffic to use lane 2 of the southbound carriageway in a contraflow manner;

(5) close the southbound carriageway of the A43 from a point 250 metres south of the centrepoint of Abthorpe Roundabout to a point 1150 metres south of the centrepoint of Abthorpe Roundabout and allow traffic to use lane 2 of the northbound carriageway in a contraflow manner;

(6) prohibit any vehicle from overtaking a moving vehicle on the lengths of the A43 described in (4) and (5) above;

(7) prohibit any vehicle with an overall width exceeding 3.3 metres from entering or proceeding on the lengths of the A43 described in (4) and (5) above; and

(8) prohibit any vehicle from entering or leaving the length of the A43 described in (3)(a) above at the junction with any side road or access road.

The work started on Saturday 23 November 2024 and is expected to continue for a further nineteen months. The closures and prohibition described in paragraphs (3)(a), (3)(b) and (8) above will be in operation overnight between 20:00 and 06:00 hours. The speed restrictions and layby closures will be in operation 24 hours per day for the duration of the works. The contraflow, overtaking ban and width restriction will be carried out in two phases starting in January 2025 and continuing for approximately 11 months.

This Order will come into force on Monday 6 January 2025 and will remain in force until completion of the work.

Any vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes will be exempt from the speed restrictions, closures and prohibition. Special forces vehicles will be exempt from the speed restrictions and vehicles being used in connection with the works or for winter maintenance purposes will be exempt from the closures and prohibition. No vehicles will be exempt from the contraflow. Access to properties will be maintained at all times.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Brent on 30th December 2024 made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985, the Parking Acts of 1986 and 1989 and the Traffic Management Act 2004.

2. The general effect of the 'Waiting and Loading Restriction' Order will be to further amend the Brent (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1979, so that:-

(a) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be prohibited at any time in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice;

(b) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be prohibited in the times and in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice;

(c) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 40 minutes in the same place will be prohibited at the times and in the lengths of streets specified in Schedules 1 and 2 to this Notice;

(d) the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle will be prohibited (except on Sundays) in the lengths of streets specified in Schedules 1 and 2 to this Notice, unless there is in force a valid licence issued by the Brent Borough Council or the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;

(e) the use of any vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume, wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising will be prohibited in the lengths of streets specified in Schedules 1 and 2 to this Notice;

(f) any existing prohibition on the waiting by vehicles, the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle or the use of any vehicle or animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising in the lengths of streets specified in Schedules 1 and 2 to this Notice will be revoked.

3. The prohibitions referred to in sub-paragraphs 2(a) to (c) inclusive above will not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in certain circumstances, e.g., the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; the taking in of petrol, etc., from roadside petrol stations; to licensed street traders, etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "Blue Badge" will apply.

4. The general effect of the 'Electric Vehicle Charging Points' Order will be to introduce electric vehicle charging points in certain lengths of streets specified in Schedule 3 to this Notice.

5. The charging points referred to in paragraph 4 above will be available for electric vehicles only "at any time", without charge, provided that:-

(a) the vehicle is connected to the charging post via the re-charging lead provided at all times while it is left at the charging point;

(b) the usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "Blue Badge" will apply.

6. The general effect of the 'Parking Places' Orders will be to:-

(a) reduce in length existing:-

i. shared use permit or pay parking places in Crawford Avenue, Kings Road, Morduant Road, Odessa Road and Winchelsea Road;

ii. a permit parking place in Outgate Road;

iii. resident permit parking places in Hiley Road and Radcliffe Avenue;

iv. Wembley stadium event day parking places in Gloucester Close and The Circle;

(b) revoke:-

i. permit parking places in Denzil Road and Leighton Gardens;

ii. a Wembley stadium event day parking place in Morland Gardens, to facilitate the introduction of the electric vehicle charging points.

7. 8 Where the Publisher is responsible for a failure to publish, or has published a Notice in error or with an error, the Publisher shall, at no charge to the Notice Placer, either publish the Notice at the next suitable opportunity, or in the event of an error, remove the Notice or publish a reinsertion, retraction or substitution Notice as appropriate at the next suitable opportunity. Both parties agree (including on behalf of any principal, if applicable) that this shall be the sole remedy of the Notice Placer (including any principal, if applicable) and the full extent of the limit of the Publisher's liability in these circumstances.

9 In the event that the Publisher believes, in its sole opinion, a Notice Placer is submitting Notices in bad faith, is in breach of clause 11 below, or has dealings with Notice Placers who are in breach of these Terms and Conditions or has breached such Terms and Conditions previously, the Publisher may require further verification of information to be provided by the Notice Placer and may, at its sole and absolute discretion, delay publication of those Notices until it is satisfied that the Notice it has received is based on authentic information.

10 The location of the Notice in The Gazette shall be at the discretion of the Publisher. For the avoidance of doubt, the Notice shall be published in the house style of The Gazette.

11 The Notice Placer warrants and undertakes to the Publisher:

11.1 that it has the (legal) right, power and authority to submit the Notice;

11.2 the Notice is true and accurate in all respects and does not mislead or contain potentially fraudulent information;

11.3 the Notice is submitted in good faith, does not contravene any law (statutory or otherwise), nor is it in any way illegal, defamatory or an infringement of any other party's rights or of any applicable advertising regulations, guidelines or codes of practice, nor is it subject to any court order prohibiting such publication.

12 To the extent permissible by law the Publisher excludes all warranties, conditions or other terms, whether implied by statute or otherwise, relating to the placing of any Notices.

The Notice Placer agrees and accepts that the Publisher is reliant upon the services of the Royal Mail in order to deliver the Forwarding Service and accordingly any failure and/or inability of the Royal Mail to deliver the Forwarding Service shall in so far as reasonably possible not put the Publisher to be in breach of this Agreement unless the Publisher was the sole contributory to the breach and/or negligent on its part to properly supervise the Royal Mail in relation to the Services.

13 The Notice Placer agrees to fully indemnify (as a debt) and hold the Publisher and The National Archives or any successor organisation, including any affiliates, officers, directors, agents, subcontractors and employees harmless from all liabilities, costs, expenses, damages and losses (including, without limitation) any direct, indirect, consequential and/or special losses and/or damage, loss of profit, loss of reputation and/or goodwill and all interest, penalties and legal costs (calculated on a full indemnity basis) and all other professional costs and/or expenses (including legal costs) suffered or incurred (including negligence) in respect of any matter

arising out of, in connection with or relating to any Notice (including, without limitation, clause 11 of the Terms and Conditions) and including (without limitation) in respect of any claim and/or demand (including threatened and/or potential claims or demands) made by any third party which may constitute a breach and/or potential breach by the Notice Placer (or their principal) of these Terms and Conditions or of any law and/or any of the rights of a third party. The Publisher shall consult with the Notice Placer as to the way in which such applicable claims, demands or potential claims or demands are handled but the Publisher shall retain the sole, absolute and final decision on all aspects of any matter arising from the aforementioned indemnity, including the choice of instructing legal representatives, steps taken in or related litigation and/or decisions to settle the case. The Notice Placer shall use best endeavours to provide, at its own expense, such co-operation and assistance as the Publisher may reasonably request including in respect of any principal (if applicable) and including, without limitation, the provision of and/or access to witnesses, access to premises and delivery up of documents and/or any evidence, including supporting any associated litigation and/or dispute resolution process.

14 The Notice Placer shall promptly notify the Publisher in writing of any actual, threatened or suspected claim made by a third party or parties against the Notice Placer and/or the Publisher in relation to a Notice. The Publisher reserves the right, following a claim or threatened claim, to immediately remove the Notice which is the subject of the complaint from the website at www.thegazette.co.uk and all other websites controlled by the Publisher containing the Notice, as well as from any other medium in which the Notice has been placed that is controlled by The Gazette, where possible. The Publisher may (at its sole and absolute discretion) require the Notice Placer to amend the Notice at its own cost before it agrees to re-publish the Notice if it is capable of rectification to avoid the claim, threatened or suspected claim. Any reinstatement of the Notice shall be at the sole and absolute discretion of the Publisher, whose decision in respect of such matter shall be final.

In exceptional circumstances, for example if the Notice was found by the Publisher to have been submitted by an unauthorised Notice Placer, the Publisher (upon receiving written approval from The National Archives) will remove a Notice in its entirety from www.thegazette.co.uk, but will retain the Notice identification online and include explanatory text saying why and when the Notice was removed.

15 The Notice Placer acknowledges that the Publisher may re-use Notices and/or allow third parties to re-use Notices accepted for publication in The Gazette for ongoing Gazette-related activity – for example to create a company profile page on The Gazette website and where you have also opted for a newspaper advertisement as well as a Gazette notice – and hereby assigns to the Publisher for and on behalf of the Crown, all rights, including but not limited to, copyright and/or other such intellectual property rights (as applicable) in all Notices, and warrants that any such activity in respect of any Notice (including any activity in the preparation of such Notice for publication in The Gazette) by the Publisher and/or third parties does not and will not infringe any legal right of the Notice Placer or any third party. For the avoidance of doubt, all Notices and any content therein shall be Crown copyright and may be subject to the Open Government Licence (or any variation thereof).

16 The Notice Placer accepts that the purpose of The Gazette is to disseminate information of interest to the public as widely as possible in the public interest. The Notice Placer accepts that the information contained in the Notices published in The Gazette may be used for additional purposes by the Publisher or third parties after publication as stated above and that such use may be beyond the control of The Gazette. In such instances, the Notice Placer agrees that the Publisher shall have no liability whatsoever in respect of such use by the Publisher or third parties. The Gazette will at all times act with confidentiality, discretion and adhere to any legislative requirements.

17 The Notice Placer acknowledges and agrees that the publication of any Notice is subject to any court order and/or direction of the court or such other regulatory and/or enforcement authorities including the Information Commissioner's Office, the police, the Financial Conduct Authority (and such other related regulatory organisations), the Solicitors Regulation Authority and such other authorities as may be applicable (without limitation) and that the Publisher may delay, refuse to publish or withdraw from publication if it has received evidence to that effect and may not publish such notice until it has received written evidence from the court (as the

Publisher may reasonably require from time to time) that demonstrates that any previous order and/or direction has been withdrawn and/or is no longer applicable (as the Publisher may reasonably require from time to time) and/or, subject to any statutory and/or applicable laws, The Gazette may share information and/or data related to the Notice and/or the Notice Placer's account related to such authorities and the Notice Placer hereby consents to such disclosure(s).

18 In respect of any Local Newspaper Notice, this clause 18 shall apply. For the avoidance of doubt, all other terms of the Terms and Conditions shall apply to Local Newspaper Notices only to the extent that they do not conflict with the terms set out below. In the event of any conflict, the terms set out in this clause 18 shall prevail:

18.1 The Local Newspaper Notice may be placed in a local newspaper by any subcontractor and/or a third party organisation at the Publisher's sole and absolute discretion and the Notice Placer hereby consents to such use (including any activity that is ancillary and/or reasonably necessary to such use). For the avoidance of doubt, this may include the processing of personal data in accordance with the EU General Data Protection Regulation (Regulation 2016/679), and any legislation which implements, amends, re-enacts or replaces it in England and Wales, Northern Ireland or Scotland ("GDPR"), by the Publisher, any subcontractor and/or third party organisation, together with the local newspaper and related organisations;

18.2 The placement of a Local Newspaper Notice shall be upon the standard terms and conditions of the local newspaper in question in addition to these Terms and Conditions. The Notice Placer expressly agrees to such local newspaper terms and by submitting a Local Newspaper Notice to The Gazette, expressly consents to the Publisher, its subcontractors and/or any applicable third party organisation agreeing to such terms on behalf of the Notice Placer;

18.3 To the extent that such local newspaper and the applicable terms allow, where the Publisher, any subcontractor, any third party acting on behalf of the Publisher and/or the local newspaper is responsible for any error, the Publisher shall arrange for the local newspaper to publish the corrected Local Newspaper Notice at no additional cost to the Notice Placer. Both parties agree (including on behalf of any principal, if applicable) that this shall be the sole remedy of the Notice Placer (including any principal, if applicable) and the full extent of the limit of liability in these circumstances;

In the event that a corrected Local Newspaper Notice is not published for whatever reason, the total aggregate liability of the Publisher and The National Archives, whether direct or indirect, and including (without limitation) all liabilities, losses, damages, expenses, costs (including all interest, penalties, legal costs and/or other professional costs and/or expenses) suffered or incurred, howsoever arising (including negligence), whether arising from the acts and/or omissions of the Publisher, The National Archives and/or the Notice Placer and/or any third party (including, without limitation, any principal of the Notice Placer) or arising out of or made in connection with the Notice or otherwise shall be limited to the value of the Local Newspaper Notice placed through The Gazette except that nothing in these Terms and Conditions shall

limit or exclude any liability for fraudulent misrepresentation, or for death or personal injury resulting from the Publisher's or The National Archives' negligence or the negligence of their agents, subcontractors and/or employees or third parties acting on behalf of the Publisher.

19 In respect of the use of the Forwarding Service, which is subject to Clause 12 (above), The Gazette will replace the Notice Placer or executor's address with The Gazette's postal box address in the Notice, and Local Newspaper Notice if applicable. All correspondence received will be sent via Royal Mail from The Gazette to the Notice Placer or executor (if different).

Please be aware that correspondence received by The Gazette's postal box (subject to the final condition of the mail and delivery of the same), will using reasonable endeavours be opened, scanned, and securely stored. The scans will be retained for as long as the service remains (paid for and) in place and for a period of 6 months beyond that time, so that any copies of claims can be requested and communicated to the executor (for example in circumstances where Royal Mail has failed to deliver a claim) and in using this service you are consenting to the provisions of this clause; The Gazette will at all times act with confidentiality, discretion and adhere to any legislative requirements.

The Forwarding Service will remain in place for a period of 10 months from publication of the Notice in The Gazette, or 10 months from publication of the Notice in a Local Newspaper, in line with the Inheritance (Provision for Family and Dependents) Act 1975. After the 10 months period has lapsed any correspondence received will be posted to the sender where possible and or securely destroyed, and the Notice Placer or executor's name and address details will be removed from the Forwarding Service.

20 The Notice Placer accepts that the Charges may be amended from time to time and will be payable at the rate in force at the time of invoicing unless otherwise agreed by the Publisher in writing. The Charges must be paid in full by the Notice Placer in advance of publication unless other requirements of the Publisher in respect of the payment of such Charges (as determined from time to time) are notified to the Notice Placer.

24 These Terms and Conditions and all other express terms of the contract shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales and the parties hereby submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts.
