The Secretary of State gives notice of the proposal to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up and diversion of a length of Canewdon Footpath 1 at Rochford, in the District of Rochford.

If made, the Order would authorise the stopping up only to enable development to be carried out should planning permission be granted by Rochford District Council. The Secretary of State gives notice of the draft Order under Section 253 (1) of the Act.
