TRENT TOPSIDES AND RISER SECTIONS DECOMMISSIONING PROGRAMMES

Perenco UK Limited has submitted, for the consideration of the Secretary of State for Energy Security and Net Zero, draft Decommissioning Programmes for the Trent field topsides and riser sections, in accordance with the provisions of the Petroleum Act 1998. It is a requirement of the Act that interested parties be consulted on such decommissioning proposals.

The Decommissioning Programmes detail the removal of the Trent Production Platform (TP) and Trent Compression Platform (TC) topsides, including the top of the pipeline riser sections of PL253b, PL1220 and PL1221 on the TP, and PL2162 and PL2163 on the TC.

The Trent installation is located in the Trent Field (UKCS Block 43/24a) in the Southern North Sea. The TP is a small, fixed steel structure while the TC is a Mobile Offshore Application Barge. The two topsides are connected by a 30m long bridge.

The WGS84 co-ordinates of the installations are:

• **Trent TP:** 54° 17' 56.1539" N, 01° 39' 30.3669" E.

• **Trent TC:** 54° 17' 55.1744" N, 01° 39' 28.4183" E.

The Trent installation is located within the Southern North Sea Special Area of Conservation (SAC) for the Harbour Porpoise and is located 9.6km south of the Dogger Bank SAC, a designated site for the Annex I Sandbanks habitat.
