TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State hereby gives notice of the proposal to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of a length and part width of Daltons Lane and an irregular shaped area of highway to the south of Daltons Lane adjoining The Customs House at South Shields, in the Metropolitan Borough of South Tyneside.

If the Order is made, the stopping up will be authorised only to enable development as permitted by South Tyneside Council. The Secretary of State gives notice of the draft Order under Section 253 (1) of the Act.

Copies of the draft order and relevant plan will be available for inspection during normal opening hours at The Word, National Centre for the Written Word, 45 Market Place, South Shields, NE33 1JF in the 28 days commencing on 6 October 2025, and may be obtained, free of charge, from the Secretary of State (quoting NATTRAN/NE/S247/6107) at the address stated below.

Objections should be received by midnight on **3 November 2025**.
