VERY thing now tending to the fpeedy Acceffion of this Republick to the Treaty of Hanover, the Augmentation of Six Thousand Men in the Infantry is already approved of; and the Provinces of Holland and Guelderland infift upon a more confiderable Augmentation, in order to increase the Number of Troops belonging to this State to Fifty Thousand Men.
