1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Westminster City Council proposes to make the above Order under sections 6, 45, 46, 49, 63 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Order would be to:

(a) relocate the pay-by-phone parking bay on the west side of Dean Street, opposite The Crown & Two Chairmen Public House, Nos. 31-32, northward by 23 metres to outside No. 76 Dean Street, replacing 5.8 metres of double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions; and

(b) extend the double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions outside Royalty House, Nos. 72-74 Dean Street, northward by 5.8 metres.
