NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under Sections 6, 45, 46, 49,51 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

In order to accommodate the introduction of 'dropped kerb' vehicle crossovers to enable access to off-street parking facilities, the general effect of the Orders would also be to remove existing parking spaces and replace with yellow line waiting restrictions outside the locations as follows:

47 Pattison Road NW2	Resident permit holders only	One	Monday to Friday 10am to 11am waiting restriction

In order to maximise on street parking provision it is also proposed to introduce a length of resident permit holder only parking (operational 10am to 6.30pm Monday to Saturday) outside No. 12 Layfield Crescent NW4, by converting a length of existing single yellow line waiting restriction, and a length of resident permit holders only parking (operational 8am to 6.30pm Monday to Friday) opposite 53/55 Booth Road NW9, by converting a length of existing single yellow line waiting restriction.
