BY Letters of the 1st Instant from Paris we had an Account of his most Christian Majesty's being recovered of the Small-Pox; upon which his Catholick Majesty left his Apartment, and appeared in Publick, and received the Compliments of the foreign Ministers and other Persons of Distinction, upon the Recovery of his own Health, as well as that of the King of France his Nephew; and on Sunday the 14th his Majesty, with the Royal Family, went to pay their Devotions at the Convent of Nuestra Sennora de Atocha. Letters from Cadiz advise, that on the 8th Instant the San Antonio arrived at that Port from the Havana; and that on the 9th Instant an Advice-Ship called Nuestra Sennora de la Soledad arrived there from Terra-Firma, and brings an Account that the Azogue Ships arrived safe at la Vera-Cruz on the 25th of July last. The Duke of Richmond arrived here the 15th Instant.

Paris, Nov. 30, N. S. The King has made a Promotion amongst the Sea-Officers who served at the late bombarding of Tripoli: The Chevalier Thomas de Chateaufort Captain of the Artillery, who commanded a Bomb-Vessel, is made Captain of a Man of War; the Chevalier de Crefnay Lieutenant of Artillery, who likewise commanded a Bomb-Vessel, is made Captain of the Artillery; M. Vieux Chastel Sub-Lieutenant of Artillery, is made Lieutenant; the Baron de Chafan Aide of Artillery, is made Sub-Lieutenant; and M. Mouver, a Garde-Marine, is made Aide of the Artillery. His Majesty has likewise made Chevaliers of St. Louis M. de Préville, M. du Pin de Bellyer, and M. des Fosses, all three Lieutenants of Artillery. On the 19th Instant the Cardinal de Fleury made a Visit to the Cardinal de Noailles here, and went that Evening to Versailles. The General of the Capuchins being arrived in this Town, he will shortly

répair to Versailles in the King's Coach, as usual, to have an Audience of their most Christian Majesties. The King allows 3000 Livres for his Expences. Orders are given for cutting 69 new Avenues or Ridings in the Forest of Compeigne. The Archbishop of Narbonne sets out this Week for Languedoc, to be present at the opening of the States there. On the 25th the Archbishop of Rouen performed the Ceremony of the Marriage of the Count de Bermont with Mademoiselle Sovin, Daughter to the Receiver-General of the Finances. The King has given a Present of 4000 Livres to M. Laubespain, Commissary-General of the Gallies; for his Services in the bombarding of Tripoli.
