ESTERDAY being the Anniverfary of the Emprefs's Birthday, when fhe entered into the 41ft Year of her Age, it was celebrated at Court with great Magnificence. The Elector of Mentz having notified his Defign to come hither by the 6th of next Month, the Ceremonial for his Reception is fettled.

Copenhagen, Sept. 1. The 29th paft, being the Birth-day of the Princes's Sophia-Hedwig, the King's Aunt, who then entred into the 55th Year of her Age, the Principal Lords and Ladies of the Court repaired to Friedensbourg to pay their Compliments: Mourning was laid afide that Day. M. de Biedersee, Minister from the King of Prussia, has had an Audience of Leave of his Danish Majesty, and is preparing to return to Berlin.

Cassel, Sept. 3. The King of Sweden, accompanied by the Landgrave of Heffe-Darmstadt, and several other Prinfet out from thence for these Provinces

ccs and Lords, took a Review a few Days ago of Four Regiments of Foot, and Three of Horfe. It is faid his Swedifh Majefty will fet out To-morrow for Marpurg; but it is yet uncertain whether he will go to use the Waters of Slangenbad. General Count Seckendorff is arrived here from Berlin.

Hague, Sept. 11, N.S. An Affembly of the States of the Province of Holland will be held To-morrow. Their great Penfionary being perfectly free from his ufual Indifposition of the Gout, will attend them. An extraordinary Deputation from Zealand, and the Commiffaries of the feveral Chambers of Admiralty, are expected here before the faid Affembly breaks up. Yesterday a Collection was made throughout the Province of Holland, and the like will be made in the other Provinces, for the Relief of the poor Vaudois, who have been obliged to leave their native Country on Account of Religion.
