

#### A PROCLAMATION.

Peers of the prefent Parliament of Great Britain, and is fince deceased; in order to the electing another Peer of Scotland to fit in his Room, We do, by the Advice of our Privy Council, iffue forth this our Royal Proclamation, firictly charging and commanding all the Peers of Scotland to affemble and meet at Holy-Rood Houfe in Edinburgh, on Friday the Twenty Eighth Day of January next enfuing, between the Hours of Twelve and Two in the Afternoon, to nominate and chule another Peer of Scotland, to fit and vote in the Houle of Peers of this prefent Parliament of Great Britain, in the Room of the faid Hugh Earl of Loudoun deceased, by open Election and Plurality of Voices of the Peers that shall be then present, and of the Proxies for fuch as shall be absent, fuch Proxies being Peers, and producing a Mandate in Writing, duly figned before Witneffcs, and both the Conflituent and Proxy being quali-fied according to Law. And the Lord Clerk Register, or such two of the Principal Clerks of the Seffion as shall be appointed by him to officiate in his Name, are hereby respec-tively required to attend fuch Meeting, and to administer the Oaths required by Law to be taken there by the faid Peers, and to take their Votes; and immediately after fuch Election made and duly examined, to certify the Name of the Peer fo elected, and fign and atteft the fame in Prefence of the faid Peers, and Return fuch Certificate into our High Court of Chancery of Great Britain. And we ftrictly charge and command that this our Royal Proclamation be duly published at the Market-Crofs at Edinburgh, and in all the County Towns of Scotland, Twenty Five Days at the leaft before the Time hereby appointed for the Meeting of the faid Peers to proceed to fuch Election.
