N Wednefday last the Emperor held a Council of State, at which Count Charles de Konigfeg took the Oath in Quality of an actual Member there-Yefterday the Aulick Council declared, of. that his Imperial Majesty had refolved to grant the Elector of Bavaria the Investiture of his Eftates, and that it would be done very fhortly with the usual Ceremony. Befides the Troops that are actually marching towards Italy, Sixty Squadrons of Cuiraffiers, Thirty of Dragoons, Twenty Battallions, and Eighteen Companies of Grenadiers, are to be drawn from the Hereditary Countries, which are to be replaced by the new Regiments that are railing, and which will be compleated in a very fhort Time. It is affured that Prince Eugene of Savoy will command in Italy, and that his Equipage is getting ready, as also that of Count Neffelroodt, Commillary General of the Army.

Hague, Dec. 18, N. S. By the laft Poft from Vienna we learn, that the Emperor has refuled to accept of the Neutrality for the Auftrian Low Countries offered by France. The Imperial Ministers prefented a Memo-tial laft Saturday to the States. The State of War for the enfuing Year was prefented on the 14th Inftant to the States General, by the Council of State, in order to be tranfmitted to the feveral Provinces, and it is regulated upon the fame Foot as it was for The Marquess de Fenelon this laft Year. has delivered to the States, a Letter of No-tification from King Staniflaus, of his Elec-tion to the Crown of Poland.
