H E King of Denmark has kept free from any Return of his Illneis for this Week paft, and was prefent Yefterday at the Council which was held at Friedenburg; but his Majefty ftill avoids the Fatigue of coming out into his Circle, and of dining in Publick.

Circle, and of dining in Publick. Berlin, Aug. 25, N. S. Yefterday the King of Prullia fet out from Potzdam for Wulterhaulen. M. Thulemeyer, who has the chief Hand in the Difpatch of Affairs at this Court, is gone to the Baths of Toplitz in Bohemia, for the Recovery of his Health. M. Pollman, the Prullian Kelident at Cologne, is appointed his Prullian Majefty's Mimitter at the Diet of Ratisbon, in the Room of M. Danckleman, who defired fome Time ago his Difmittion from that Poft. On Monday laft the Princefs Royal of Prullia removed from hence to a Country Houle near Rupin, the Prince Royal her Confort's Quarters, where their Royal Highnefles are chiefly to refide for the future. General Ginkel, the Dutch Minister, is still here, but defigns to fet out for Holland To-morrow by the Way of Caffel.

Hague, Aug. 31, N. S. His Highnels Prince William of Helle Callel arrived here the 27th Inftant in the Morning from Loo, whither he had been to wait on the Prince, and her Royal Highnels the Princels, of Orange. It is faid this Prince of Helle Callel will continue three or four Weeks at this Place, deligning to follicit the States Leave to refign, in Favour of the Prince his Son, the Command of a Regiment of Dragoons which his Highnels at prefent has in the States Service. Since the Prince's Arrival here, he has been vifited by all the Foreign Ministers and other People of the best Fashion in this Town, except the Amballadors, who upon Point of Ceremony pretend to expect the first Visit from him. M. Imberti, Minister from the Republick of Venice, who was lately at the Court of Great Britain, but is now

come hither from England, is directed by his Mafters to flay at this Place till he receives fome farther Orders from them.

Hanover, Aug. 26, N. S. His Majefty has been pleafed to conftitute and appoint Richard Ellis, Efq; to be Captain, Archibald Campbell, Efq; Captain Lieutenant, Henry Erskine, Lieutenant, and Mark Kerr, Enfign, in the Regiment of Foot commanded by Colonel James St. Clair.

His Majerty has likewise been pleafed to conftitute and appoint George Beauclerk, Esq; commonly called Lord George Beauclerk, to be Captain of a Company in the First Regiment of Foot Guards, commanded by the Right Honourable Sir Charles Wills, Knight of the Bath.
