**A**BOUT Seven a-Clock this Evening the Right Reverend Dr. Secker, Lord Bishop of Oxford, Rector of St. James Westminster, performed the Ceremony of Baptizing, by the Name of Elizabeth - Carolina, the young Princess, second Daughter of their Royal Highnesses the Prince and Princess of Wales: The Godfather was the Marquis of Anspach, represented by the Right Honourable the Lord Baltimore; and the Godmothers were the Queen of Denmark, and the Dutchess of Saxe-Gotha, represented by the Right Honourable the Lady Viscountess Irwin, and the Lady of Lord Archibald Hamilton. His Royal Highness the Prince was present, as was her Royal Highness, sitting on a Bed of State, the Lords and Ladies of their Bedchamber attending.
