and Perfons as they shall find playing or prefent in such Gaming Houses or Places; and also the Keepers of such Houses and Places, and of diforderly or lewd Houses, and carry all of them the next Day before one of His Majesty's Justices of the Peace, in order to be dealt with according to Law.

And it is alfo ordered, That all Conftables, Beadles and Peace-Officers shall apprehend all Beggars lying in the Streets, or wandering and begging there, either by Day or Night; all Perfons driving or carrying Orange Barrows, and inticing Servants and Children to play for them; all perfons prophanely Curfing and Swearing, and carry them before one of His Majesty's Justices of the Peace for the Purposes aforefaid.

And it is hereby refolved, that His Majefty's Juffices of the Peace do hold a special Sessions in each respective Parish wherein they are relident, twice in every Week, or as Occasion shall require, in order to bring to Justice such Offenders, whose Offences shall require more than one Justice of the Peace for that Purpose. there and in the Schelde ; the Armed Veffels at the Pas have fuffered much in their Mafts and Rigging. As Admiral Schryver's Squadron is not mentioned in the Texel Lift amongit the Ships that are either loft or have fuffered, there are Hopes that they have received no Damage. All the Ships in Helvoet Road drove. His Britannick Majefty's Ship Margate and the Ferret Sloop, loft each a Maft, and Orders were immediately given from the Admiralty of the Maefe, to their Store-keeper at Helvoet, to fupply them. A Transport from Williamstadt with Invalids and recovered Men, was on Shore, but the People were all fafe.

## 'Admiralty Office, December 12.

Captain Duff, Commander of his Majefty's Ship the Anglesea, arrived at Kinsale the 27th past, and brought in with him the Extravagant Privateer belonging to St. Sebastian, of Eight Guns and One hundred and twenty Men, which he took the 25th, about 40 Leagues S. S. W. from Cape Clear.

Hague, December 15, N.S. A Deputation from the States of Overyssel arrived here two Days ago with the Refolution of that Province, by which the Dignity of Stadtholder is made hereditary in the Prince of Orange's Family, both in the Male and Female Line, without any Restrictions whatfocver. The folemn Deputation from Zealand upon the fame Occasion has been expected here these three Days; but as the Yacht that brings the Deputies has not been heard of fince last Tuesday, it is greatly feared fome Accident has happened to her in the violent Storm of Wind we had here laft Tuefday Night, of which the like is hardly remembred in this Country. As Vice-Admiral Schryver failed that very Morning for the Texel, in order to go to Sea with the Fleet under his Command, and has not been heard of fince; we are in great Apprehensions on his Account, as well as for all the Shipping in Zealand. The Packet Boat of this Day Se'nnight from England, which happened to be at Sea during the Storm, got fafe to Helvoetsluys last Night. We were informed last Night by an Express from Nimeguen, that the Day before, the Burghers of that Town having affembled to a very confiderable Number, had fent to their Magistrates, who were then met upon Business in the Stadt-House, to know their Resolution in regard to the Stadtholder's Commission and the hereditary Succession. To which the Magistrates having given their Confent, a Deputation from the Burghers of that Town arrived here this Day to acquaint the Prince of Orange with the Resolution of their Regency. Rotterdam, Dec. 15, N.S.
