

Letters from several other Towns and Places in the
Thetford Branch: The Persons who committed this
Robbery are described to be both stout Men, and one of
them was mounted on a light grey Horse, and the other
on a Brown one. He on the Grey Horse was dressed
in a Gold-laced light colour'd Waistcoat with a Great
Coat over the same, and he on the Brown one, wore a
complete Soldier's Dress, with Gold Button Holes.
