The Court goes out of Mourning on Tuef. day next, for that Day, it being His Majefty's Coronation Day.

Lisbon, Sept. 3. His Majefty's Ship the Notre Dame de Piete, and the Notre Dame dAttalaya, are arrived at the Mouth of the Tagus, in about ten Weeks, from Rio de Janeiro. We have received Advice from Elvas, that Don Francis d'Azevedo,-Governor of that City, died there, a few Days ago, if the 96th Year of his Age.
Barcelona, Sept. 15. The Squadron commanded by Don Alvarez Cabrero, which put in here fome Time ago to refit, failed again laft Sunday, and the next Day came up with an Algerine Corfair of 22 Guns, which they took atter a fmart Engagement. She failed from Algiers the 30th of laft Month, with Provifions on board for'a Cruize of forty Days; and her Crew confifted of 80 . Men, 21 of whom were killed in the Action.
Petersbourg, Sept. i6. A.Mán of War and three Frigats will foon be launched here. The Emprefs has ordered the Body of Troops, who have been for fome Time affembled on the Frontiers of Livonia, to feparate, and march into Winter Quarters.
Naples, Sept. 17. The King having been informed, that a Quarry of White Marble has been difcovered in the Province of Bafilicate, of the fame Quality with that in the Neighbourhood of Maffa Carrara, has ordered the Sieut Vanvitelli, Architect to the Court, to go and examine into it. His Majefty has caufed an Ediet to be publifhed, frrictly forbidding the Exportation of Corn or Cattle out of this Kingdom, under very fevere Penalties,

Legborn, Sept. 18. We hear from Corfica, that the Malecontents, finding themfelves unable to befiege Baftia, have retired to the Mountains, from whence they are continually fending fmall Parties to plunder the Houfes of all fuch as adhere to the Genoefe Government.

Genoa, Sept، 21. The Marquefs Doria, the new Commiffary General in Corfica, having requefted a farther Reinforcement of Troops, the Government have ordered three Companies of 100 Men each, exclufive of Officers, to be immediately fent thither, and the Embarkation began accordingly laft Monday Morning. We are informed by the Mafter of one of our Pinks that arrived here a few Days ago from Palermo, that fome Algerines, being on a Cruize on the Southern Coaft of Sicily, had made a Defcent, and carried off feven or eight Perfons, and feveral Head of Cattle.

Rome, Sept. 21. M, de la Bruyere, who, fince the Departure of the Duke de Nivernois, was charged with the Affairs of the Crown of France at this Court, died here on Wednefday laft of the Small Pox, which Diftemper has made great Havock in this City for fome Time paft.

Milan, Sept. 25. The Eftablifhment of the new Farm of Tobacco continues to create great Uneafinefles amongft the People ; and may, if not prevented, produce fome fatal Difturbance inthe State. The Duke Adminiftrator is come to a Refolution to enclofe the great Foreft between Caftelletto and Abbiate-Graffo, and to ftock the fame with Deer.

Stockholm, Sept. 28. Their Majefties, whor reached Drottningholm on the 20th Inftant, from their late Tour into Scania, are expected hear from thence next Monday. The Mẹn of War and other Ships building in feveral of the Ports of this Kingdom, for the Service of the Crowns of France and Spain, are, for the moft Part, near finihed, and 'tis imagined will put to Sea fome Time next Month for Breft and Ferrol.

Copenbagen, Sept. 28. Laft Thurfday their Majefties came to their Palace in this City for the Winter. The King has ordered four Frigats to be equipped, two of which 'tis faid are intended
