PRESENT,

The KING's most Excellent Majesty in Council.

HEREAS the Time limited by His Majefty's Order in Council, of the Ninth of November last, For paying the respective Bounties therein mentioned, to all Able and Ordinary Seamen, and also to all Able-bodied Landmen, who should voluntarily enter themfelves in His Majefty's Royal Navy ; and likewife for paying the Rewards to Perfons difcovering Seamen who thould conceal themselves, will expire upon the Fourteenth Day of this Instant January : And whereas it is judged expedient for His Majesty's Service, That the Bounties and Rewards thereby given, fhould be continued to be paid for fome Time longer ; His Majesty doth therefore, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, hereby Order, That the Bounties of Three Pounds for every Able Seaman, and of Thirty Shillings for every Ordinary Seaman, not above the Age of Fifty, nor under the Age of Twenty Years; and of Thirty Shillings for every Able-bodied Landman, not above the Age of Thirty-five, nor under the Age of Twenty Years, be continued to be paid to fuch Seamen and Landmen refpectively, who shall, on or before the Twenty-eighth Day of February next, enter themfelves in the Royal Navy, in the Manner directed by His Majesty's Proclamation of the Fourth Day of January 1757 : And likewife, That the Rewards of Two Pounds for every Able, and Twenty Shillings for every Ordinary Seaman, be continued to be paid to any Perfons who fhall, on or before the faid Twenty-eighth Day of February next, discover any Seaman or Seamen who shall conceal themfelves, fo as fuch Seaman or Seamen be taken for His Majesty's Service. Whereof all Perfons concerned are to take Notice, and govern themfelves accordingly.

The Dispositions are continuing here for the March of three Battalions of Tuscan Troops that are to go into Germany; accordingly a Draft of 400 Men out of the faid Troops, in Garrison here, were fent last Week to Leghorne, to join their Corps. On the 22d Instant M. Sels, Rear Admiral of a Dutch Squadron, arrived here from Leghorn. He has lately been at Algiers, and renewed the Peace between his Republick and the Bey of that Place.

Leghorn, Jan. 30. Yefterday arrived here His Britannick Majesty's Ship the Syren, Capt. Collingwood, Commander, with seven Sail of English Ships from Newfoundland, last from Gibraltar, loaden with Fish for this Place.
