1 Introduction

- 1.1 I, Michael David Rollings, and my colleague, Steven Edward Butt, of Rollings Butt LLP, 6 Snow Hill, London, EC1A 2AY, were appointed as Joint Liquidators of Foundation Engineering Limited ("the Company") on 15 September 2015. The affairs of the Company are now fully wound-up and this is my final account of the liquidation, which covers the period since my last progress report ("the Period").
- 1.2 The trading address of the Company was Fugro House, Hithercroft Road, Wallingford, Oxfordshire, OX10 9RB.
- 1.3 The registered office of the Company was changed to 6 Snow Hill, London, EC1A 2AY and its registered number is 00610627.

2 Receipts and Payments

2.1 At Appendix A, I have provided an account of my Receipts and Payments for the Period with a comparison to the directors' Declaration of Solvency, together with a cumulative account since my appointment at Appendix B, which provides details of the remuneration charged and expenses incurred and paid by the Liquidators.

3 Work undertaken by the Liquidators

- 3.1 This section of the report provides creditors with an overview of the work undertaken in the liquidation since 15 September 2016, together with information on the overall outcome of the liquidation.
- 3.2 From 15 September 2016, the Liquidators have prepared and submitted an annual progress report to Companies House, and they have sought and obtained tax clearance in respect of all taxes from the local and national HM Revenue & Customs offices.

Unrealisable Assets

3.3 No assets were identified on the Declaration of Solvency, therefore there are no unrealisable assets.

4 Distributions to Members

4.1 On appointment, the Company held no assets, therefore there were no distributions to the member during the liquidation.

5 Liquidators' Remuneration

- 5.1 The member approved that the basis of the Liquidators' remuneration be fixed by reference to time properly spent by them and their staff in managing the liquidation.
- 5.2 My time costs for the period from 15 September 2016 are £1,068. This represents 4.20 hours at an average rate of £254.29 per hour. Attached as Appendix C is a Time Analysis which provides details of the activity costs incurred by staff grade during this period in respect of the costs fixed by reference to time properly spent by me in managing the Liquidation. I would confirm that no fees have yet been drawn, and that fees are to be paid by a third party.
- 5.3 Also, attached as Appendix D is a cumulative Time Analysis for the period from 15 September 2015 to 16 June 2017 which provides details of my total time costs since the date of my appointment.

I can advise that since my last progress report on the liquidation dated 15 September 2016 I have not drawn any fees, however as stated, fees are to be paid by a third party.

- 5.4 Attached as Appendix E is additional information in relation to this firm's policy on staffing, the use of subcontractors, disbursements and details of our current charge-out rates by staff grade.
- 5.5 A copy of 'A Shareholders' Guide to Liquidator's Fees' is available on request.
- 5.6 Since the 15 September 2016 no Category 2 disbursements have been reimbursed, these are to be paid by a third party.

6 Conclusion

6.1 Notice was received on 16 June 2017 that the sole member was satisfied for me to submit my final account. Therefore, once this account has been delivered to the Registrar of Companies, the Liquidators will vacate office and receive their release.

Appendix E

Additional Information in Relation to the Liquidators' Fees, Expenses & Disbursements

1 Staff Allocation and the Use of Sub-Contractors

- 1.1 The general approach to resourcing our assignments is to allocate staff with the skills and experience to meet the specific requirements of the case.
- 1.2 The constitution of the case team will usually consist of a Partner, a Manager, and an Associate.

 The exact constitution of the case team will depend on the anticipated size and complexity of the assignment and the experience requirements of the assignment.

2.1 On this assignment, we have not used any professional advisors.

3 Liquidators' Expenses & Disbursements

3.1 The expenses (including disbursements) which were anticipated at the outset of the Liquidation was outlined to the members when the basis of my fees was approved.

Summary of Liquidators' expenses

- 3.2 A summary of the expenses paid by the Liquidator during the Period can be found in the Receipts and Payments account at Appendix A. An outline of the total expenses paid during the Liquidation can be found in the Receipts and Payments account at Appendix B.
- 3.3 Category 1 disbursements do not require approval. The type of disbursements that may be charged as a Category 1 disbursement to a case generally comprise of external supplies of incidental services specifically identifiable to the case, such as postage, case advertising, invoiced travel and external printing, room hire and document storage. Also, chargeable will be any properly reimbursed expenses incurred by personnel in connection with the case.
- 3.4 Category 2 disbursements do require approval. These are costs which are directly referable to the appointment in question but are not payments which are made to an independent third party and may include shared or allocated costs that can be allocated to the appointment on a proper and reasonable basis such as internal room hire, document storage or business mileage. Details of Category 2 disbursements charged by this firm (where appropriate) were provided at the time the Liquidators' fees were approved by the members.
